



FOOD BANK FACTS 2015



The Food Bank Coalition of SLO County is the only county wide hunger relief organization and celebrated its 25th anniversary in 2014.

We serve **44,000** residents in SLO County who are at risk of being hungry or food insecure, often not knowing where their next meal will come from.



Last year, we collected and distributed a record **6.1 million** pounds of food to help our neighbors struggling with hunger.

Almost **half** of the food we distributed was fresh produce, including over **200,000** pounds harvested locally by our GleanSLO Program.



We collaborate with our nation's network of Food Banks and effectively utilize our team of **1,800** dedicated volunteers. This helps keep our overhead at a very low **6%**.

We work with a network of over **200** community partners, including Agency Partners with charitable food programs and Youth Meal Site partners that host our Children's Programs.

We have **57** mobile distributions county wide. These sites cover underserved areas like San Simeon, Creston, CA Valley, Carissa Plains, San Miguel, and Nipomo.
